This download is a Windows 7 Ultimate USB Stick Edition. It is portable and contains the 32-bit version of the Windows 7 Ultimate ISO. It can be used to quickly install Windows 7 on a machine that does not have an optical drive, or it can be used to create an external installation drive that will function without installing anything on your existing operating system. The USB stick edition allows you to boot from any computer with a USB port, including netbooks, without needing extra drivers or BIOS modifications. This edition has all updates up until March 2017 and has service packs for Internet Explorer 8, 9 & 10 installed. Still have questions? See below for the full list of FAQs. Is this edition really compatible with MacOS X? This edition of Windows is not Mac or Linux compatible. However, being able to boot from USB is a plus for Mac users. Boot Camp can be used to create a Windows 7 disk image that can be used as an external hard drive on a Macbook or iMac running OS X 10.8, 10.9 or 10.10, but it cannot be used as a bootable DVD on Leopard (Mac OS X 10.5), Snow Leopard (OS X 10.6), Mavericks (OS X 10.7) or Yosemite (OS X 10.8). The installation files downloaded from Microsoft's servers should be entirely portable and will work on any computer with administrator rights. No unzipping utilities are required. However, if you would like to format your USB drive in FAT32 instead of NTFS, you can do this by using one of the various free disk formatting programs such as Gparted, Mac's Disk Utility or FreeDOS's format utility. Which operating systems can I use this on? This edition of Windows is not Mac or Linux compatible. However, being able to boot from USB is a plus for Mac users. Boot Camp can be used to create a Windows 7 disk image that can be used as an external hard drive on a Macbook or iMac running OS X 10.8, 10.9 or 10.10, but it cannot be used as a bootable DVD on Leopard (Mac OS X 10.5), Snow Leopard (OS X 10.6), Mavericks (OS X 10.7) or Yosemite (OS X 10.8). If your computer does not have a DVD/CD drive, you will need to create a bootable USB memory stick without using a computer. How do I install Windows 7 from an ISO image? In order to install from an ISO image, download the Windows 7 ISO from Microsoft's official site and burn it to a DVD or CD using something like The free Hiren's BootCD.
